(Alternating with Golf d'Esery in odd-numbered years)

Local Rules of the Competition

These regulations supplement the General Regulations of the FFGolf and the League.
The provisions of these Local Rules shall prevail over those of the General Regulations.

SCHEDULE

Closing date for entries :	Thursday 26 March 2026
Publication of Entry List and Waiting List :	Tuesday 31 March 2026
Publication of Tee Times :	Wednesday 08 April 2026

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

The competition is open to amateur players (ladies and gentlemen):

- Members of the French Golf Federation holding, at the closing date for entries, a valid licence for the current year, with a registered medical certificate or health questionnaire, and having paid the federal playing fee.
- Members of a recognised foreign federation, enclosing with their entry form proof of a valid licence for the current year and a declaration of negative answers to all questions in the health questionnaire.

Handicap Limit

- Ladies with a handicap index of 14.4 or lower.
- Gentlemen with a handicap index of 11.4 or lower..

This handicap limit applies only to players qualifying for entry solely on the basis of their handicap.

FORMAT OF PLAY

54 holes / Stroke Play / Individual Gross / 18 holes per day.

Cut after 36 holes in each category:

- Number of players: 55% of players having completed Round 1, rounded up to the nearest multiple of 3.
- Number of players qualified: the above number plus ties after 36 holes.

Categories – Tee Markers

- One Ladies' category: Tee markers IV (Blue).
- One Gentlemen's category: Tee markers II (White).

Tie-Break

In the event of a tie for first place, the players concerned shall compete in a hole-by-hole play-off on the hole(s) designated by the Tournament Committee.

If the play-off is suspended (weather conditions, lack of daylight, etc.), the tie shall be decided based on the score of the final round, then the last 9, 6, 3 holes, the last hole, and finally hole by hole backwards.

ENTRIES

Entries

Entry Fees

Players aged 25 and over:	110 €	Club Members:	55 €
Players aged 19 to 24:	65 €	Club Members:	45 €
Players under 19 :	50 €	Club Members:	35 €

Any player holding a French licence but entering as a non-FFGolf licence holder shall not be eligible for the above discounts.

Closing of Entries

Only the date of receipt of entries will be taken into account when establishing the official entry list.

Any player withdrawing after the closing date shall remain liable for the entry fee.

Entry List

Players not complying with the conditions of participation (licence, medical certificate and federal playing fee) seven days prior to the start of the competition shall be removed from the entry list.

Field Size

- Maximum number of players authorised : 120
- Maximum number of Ladies (excluding WCs) : 33
- Maximum number of wild Cards authorised : 12

10% of the field is reserved for Under-16 Gold licence holders who do not qualify through the National Amateur Ranking or handicap.

Players shall be selected in the following order:

- Players holding a foreign licence ranked within the top 2000 of the WAGR (Gentlemen) and top 1500 of the WWAGR (Ladies).
- National Amateur Ranking.
- Handicap index.
- Date of receipt of entry.

ORGANISATION

Practice Round

The official practice round is scheduled for the day preceding the competition and must be booked by calling +33 (0)4 50 43 95 50.

Draw for Tee Times

The entry list, ordered by handicap, is divided into four equal blocks (Block 1: first qualified – Block 4: last qualified).

Round 1: Block 2, then Block 1, followed by Block 3 and Block 4.

Round 2: Block 3, then Block 4, followed by Block 1 and Block 2.

Round 3: In reverse order of results.

Prizes and Prize-Giving Ceremony

The first three players in each category shall receive prizes.

The prize-giving ceremony, followed by a cocktail reception, will take place 30 minutes after the return of the last players.
